

Current Political situation and Reformation of Bangladesh

After the anti-discrimination movement of July by the students of Bangladesh, the entire country is in a very vulnerable position. With no one to overlook the general civilians, the country is at unrest. A couple hours after the Ex Prime minister Sheakh Hasina had fled the country, the Chief of the Army General Staff had given a public speech about the whole situation and promised to do everything in his power to keep the country stable. Even after then we witnessed a lot of vandalism and attacks on the minority groups of people in the whole country. The army was dispatched all over the civil society even then each night passed with terror as houses at random was being broken into and robbed, innocent people suffered, families with political backgrounds suffered the most. Many Ex-leaders of Awami league being killed and hanged by mob groups. Although eventually most of it was stabilized, when Dr. Muhammad Yunus took over as the Chief Advisor of the Interim Government.

Currently the interim government is trying their level best to stabilize the economy which was hanging by a thread, caused by the ex-government regime leaving Bangladesh with \$175.903 billion of total loans and 9.88% inflation rate. But in the last two months the interim government paid off 1 billion dollars of electricity bought from India without withdrawing any cash from the reserve. The interim government is also taking help from foreign countries like Algeria, Egypt, United States, Japan, Canada and other countries to build new industries and organizations throughout the country to stabilize the economy and create as many jobs as possible. The Interim Government are also passing new laws and regulations for health and hygiene. For example, they have banned use of polythin plastic bags to keep the cities clean, they will also be banning mass use of cigarettes and E-Cigarettes, to stop minors getting addicted and public smoking. The Interim Government has also fixed the metro metro Rail stations which were damaged during the protests with the lowest possible expense but also maintaining the highest quality. They have also banned the student division of Awami league (Chatro League) and declared it as a terrorist organisation.

The Interim Government is taking steps to fix the long-prolonged issues of the country but they still lack to take measures to ease up the civilians. Every other day a new protest is being held by groups of people demanding their rights and make their voice be heard. But every protest is ethical and meaningful. Some students are protesting demanding equal

grades of exams for every student, some are demanding to ban admission tests in universities. Some rickshaw pullers are demanding to bring back electric rickshaws, which is highly dangerous for a dense city like Dhaka. For most of these baseless protests, important issues are being covered like the Guerilla force of Bandits in hills of Khagrachari and Sajek.

There's been an increase of number of mob groups and student political groups. Organizing Rallies and Harassing Civilians. The other Political parties have come out of their hiding and has already started their promotions and rallies throughout the country. For Example, Bangladesh Nationalist party (BNP) and Bangladesh Jamat E Islami, celebrating and trying to take control as if they have already won the election. Posting banners and extorting businesses.

The army has been given judicial authority to arrest anyone causing disruption and is still deployed all over the country, they'e trying their level best to maintain peace and order. Even after so many people of ex leaders of the Awami league party are trying to disrupt reformation, using their old connections and allies trying to disrupt every step taken.

The police force has been deployed again with new recruits and are arresting key figures of the ex regime. After further investigation, we have come to know that it was not just the students but the other political parties had huge contribution for bringing down the ex-government regime, for which they want their credit and benefits to be obtained.

Overall, the Interim government is focused to fix the economical disorder of the country and army forces and the police are trying to stabilize the mob groups and political outbreaks. New advisors are being appointed in the interim government to manage every industry and every sector of the country. Ex judges, justices, lawyers, police chief, army officials have been arrested and are still in trial.
